Code of Conduct: Swimmers and Parents

- All swimmers shall be treated equally no matter their position in the club.
- People should be encouraged to participate in sport for enjoyment.
- All members and parents must use appropriate language during all club-sanctioned activities.
- Operate without bias or favouritism.
- The club functions through the goodwill of volunteers. Be mindful and considerate of expectations and requests.

Code of Conduct: Committee Members

Committee members shall abide by the standards listed above, and also:

- Be financial members of Lawson ASC (Dry Membership or Swimming Members).
- Be aware of and abide by the content of our club constitution.
- All committee members who are 18 years or older are required to provide a Working With Children Check and lodge with the club as soon as is practical.
- Committee operations are considered confidential until approval has been given by committee consensus.
- When contacting external organisations on behalf of LASC, ensure this is done with prior approval from a
 quorum of the committee, or by the executive committee.
- No committee member shall gain financial benefit from their role(s) within the club. The committee must approve all expenses prior to expenditure, with any conflicts of interest declared before approval is given.
- The committee will promote an emphasis on fair play.
